## FSC FOREST MANAGEMENT LEAD AUDITOR COURSE MONTEFIASCONE, ITALY, 18-20 SEPTEMBER 2013

## **Course objectives**

- 1. Understand the specific requirements of the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) with regards to the implementation of all standards, policies, guidelines and advice notes relating to forest management certification
- 2. Develop skills relating to certification of forest management to FSC standards, including controlled wood, trademark and other standards relevant to FSC FM certification.

Course type: This is a blended course. Objective 1, above, will be achieved through e-learning, while objective 2 will be achieved through face-to-face training. E-Learning and face-to-face training in English.

**Course duration:** 6 days (48 hours). The online course counts for 24 hours, and the duration of the face-to-face course is three days (24 hours)


Certificate: Upon successful completion of the course, each participant will receive an AB Training certificate.

Trainees will enroll on the AB Training platform via www.abtraining.biz following the link "enroll in a course", and marking on the registration form the box corresponding to the FM Lead Auditor blended course.

After successful registration, trainees will receive a user name and password, and will login via <a href="www.abtraining.biz">www.abtraining.biz</a> following the link "student login". Trainees receive also a link where they can download all background documentation relating to the course. Trainees are expected to study the background documentation before taking the individual course modules.

The online training program consists of various courses, modules and quizzes. The individual modules consist of a presentation with voice recording, covering all FSC FM requirements.

## Part 2: Face-to-face (F-2-F) course

The face to face course (24 hours- 3 days) is aimed at developing skills relating to auditing aginst FSC FM standards, using the knowledge acquired through the online course. The F-2-F course includes:

Group discussions about the content of the FSC FM normative framework, as presented in the online course. Clarification of concepts and standard elements (whenever required by the group, at the beginning of each exercise). Group discussions, exercises, case studies, and role plays:
